Founded over a century ago by a group of aviation enthusiasts led by O.W.H. Pratt, the club was intended to be a haven for aerial enthusiasts and their families. By October 1919, the Yolo Fliers Club had its first 100 members. The clubhouse is festooned with historical artifacts, including an antique propeller and photographs of bygone aviators, including a large, signed photograph of famed aviator Amelia Earhart.

One of the best-known features of the club, is the USAF-T-37A Jet Powered Advanced Trainer, known as "Tweety Bird." The plane is situated as though taking off and placed near the clubhouse and practice putting green. You'll not want to miss the opportunity to play at this fabulous and historical course.
